

TheAlley Church
Use of Church Building
For Covenant Members and Community Groups

Principles:

In order to provide structure for the determination of the use of the building, the following guidelines will be used to respond to usage requests of church members and the public for uses other than weddings. The building itself is a means to bring glory to God by the way it is used. It is prayerfully expected that God will draw people to Himself when we open the church doors to the community and to covenant members for uses other than worship and bible study.

Guidelines:

- Activities will not be in contradiction to the core beliefs of theAlley found in these documents: *TheAlleyWay*, *Biblical Convictions*, and *What We Believe*. These documents are available from the church bookkeeper/administrator and at theAlley.org.
- It is preferred to have a participating church member as liaison with the group requesting use of the building.
- Requests for use of the building will be directed to the church administrator/bookkeeper.
- Participating church member is responsible for clean-up and locking up the facilities. Keys will be issued by the church administrator/bookkeeper on an as-needed basis.
- The rule of 3 will be in effect meaning that if both genders are present at least 3 people must be in the building at all times.
- Donations or contributions for use of the building will be accepted, but not solicited.
- Final determination for the use of the building lies with the church administrator/bookkeeper in conjunction with the Director of Operations.
